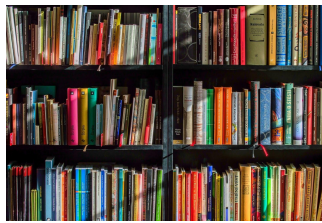


Rogers Parent Organization (RPO) Does That?
